

Trinity Newsletter for 25th March to 5th April

On Sunday 29th March at 10a.m the preacher will be the Rev. Ruth Ridge. The service will be suitable for all ages as we are hosting some visitors from Ipswich Girls Brigade. 5th April is EASTER SUNDAY and our worship at 10a.m. will be led by our Minister the Rev. Canon Jason Vinyard to include Holy Communion.

Please note - it is time to change your clocks forward on 28/29 March.

On Maundy Thursday 2nd April, at 7p.m. there will be a contemplative service with Holy Communion, also led by Rev. Canon Jason Vinyard. On Good Friday 3rd April, there is a 10.30 service with Churches Together in Bury St. Edmunds at The Cathedral. This is followed by a silent "Walk of Witness"; by the time it reaches the market place this becomes a short, inspiring open air service - often attracting shoppers to stop and ask questions or join in the hymns and listen to a short Easter message.

The Easter Sunday communion offering will be the customary Easter Offering for the work of the Methodist Church Fund for World Mission, prepared by "Methodist Women in Britain", the theme for 2026 being "Unbound: a gospel that breaks barriers", focusing on freedom.

On Sunday 26th April the Annual Meeting of the church & congregation will be held from approx. 11.30 (with coffee as usual) ending by 12.30 to facilitate your parking arrangements. All are invited to stay and learn more about the current life and work of Trinity Methodist Church and your input will be welcomed.
